## Joint Operational Programme Romania – Ukraine 2014 – 2020 CORRIGENDA TO GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS



The Managing Authority of the Joint Operational Programme Romania-Ukraine 2014-2020 extended the deadlines for applications for HARD and SOFT projects, considering the fact that May 1, 2018 is a national holiday, and April 30, 2018 is not a working day (by Government Decision). In order to prevent any difficulty that would impede the potential applicants to submit the application package in due time, the Managing Authority has decided to extend specific deadlines with several days issuing:
