

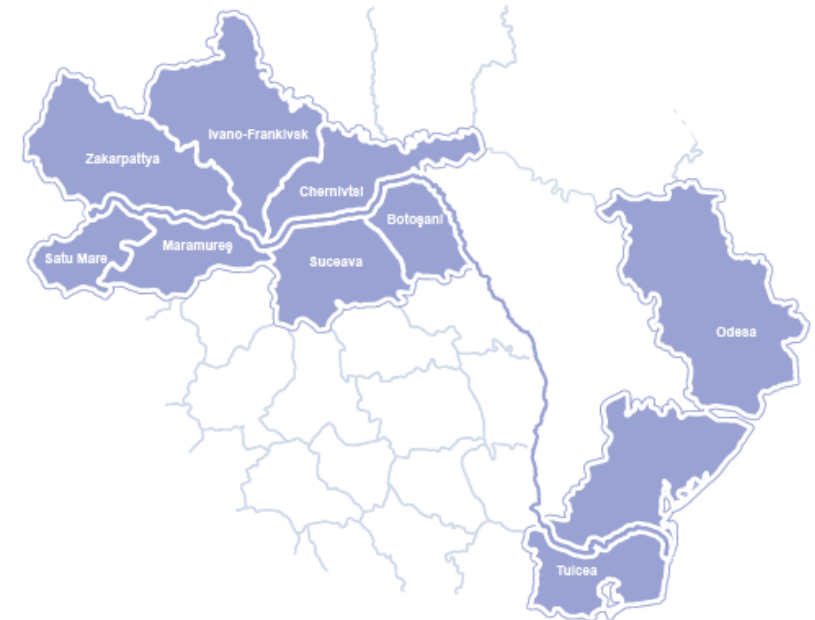

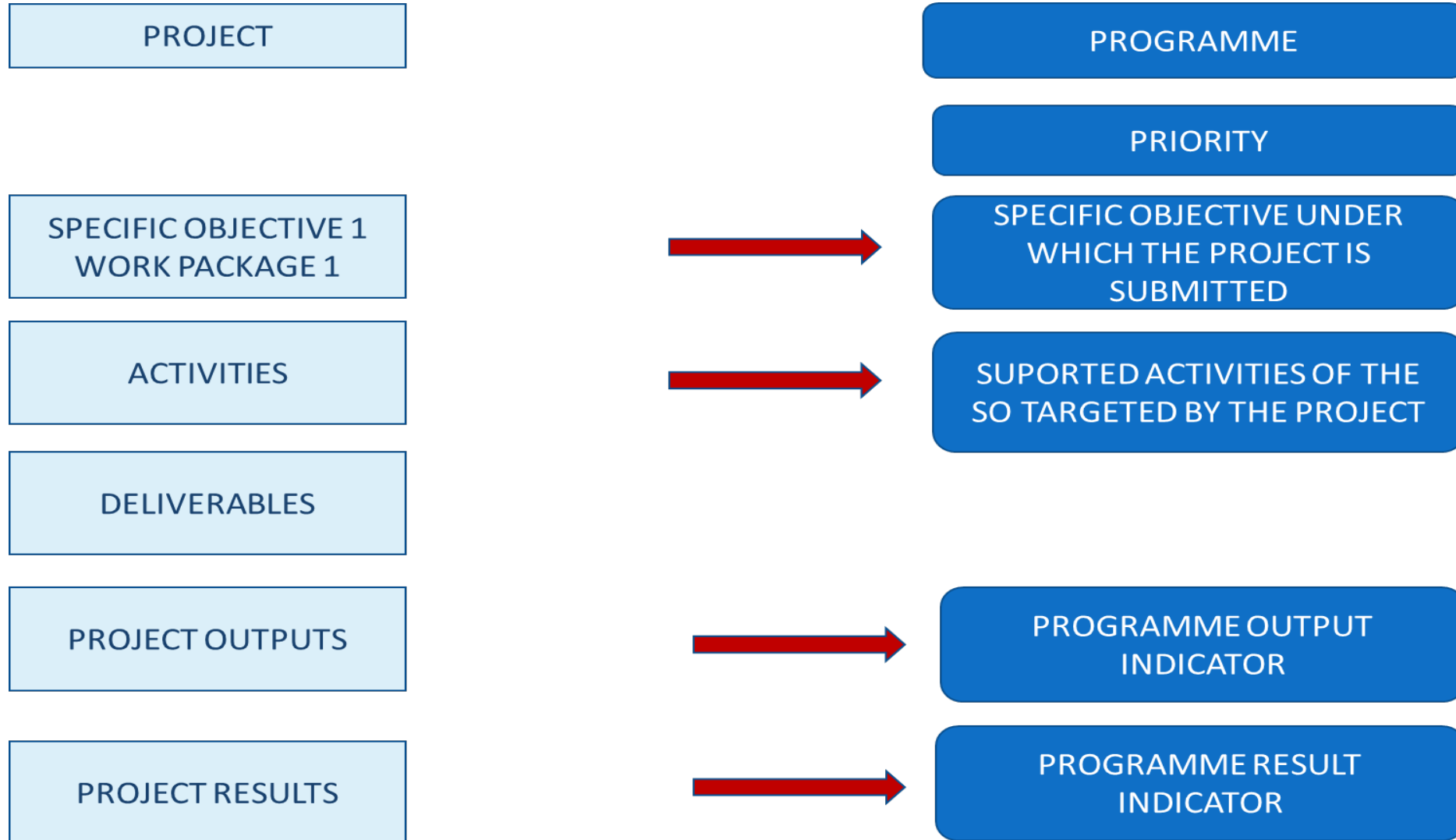

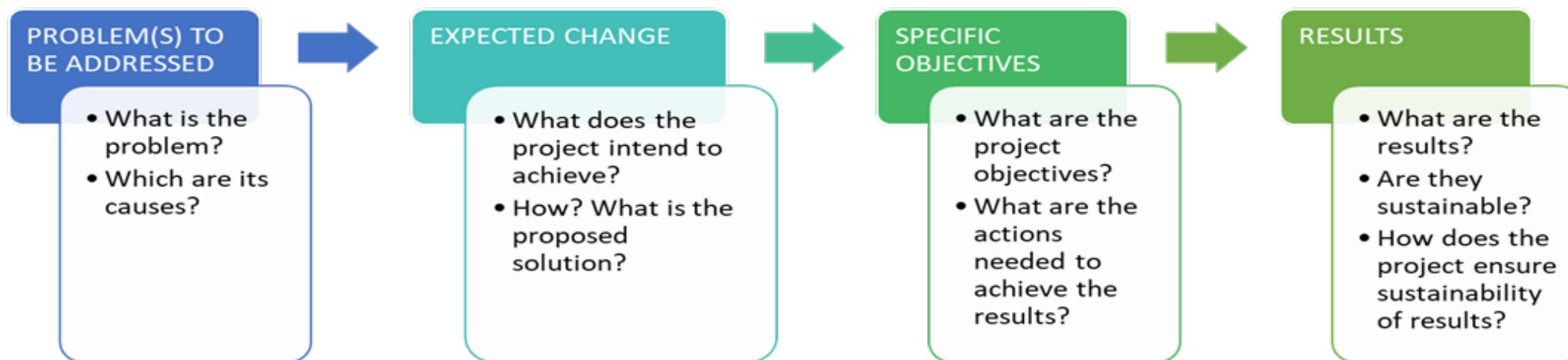
### Programme indicators and intervention logic





**TAKE NOTE THAT :**

- Any project must lead to a **change**
- A quality project intervention logic shows a sound **CAUSAL** link.



**!! Check section 2.4.2 of the Guidelines!!****(PROJECT) ACTIVITY**

- Main **implementation step**.

**(PROJECT) DELIVERABLE**

- **Physical evidence** of what is produced following an activity **OR** of the output produced through an activity.

**(PROJECT) OUTPUT**

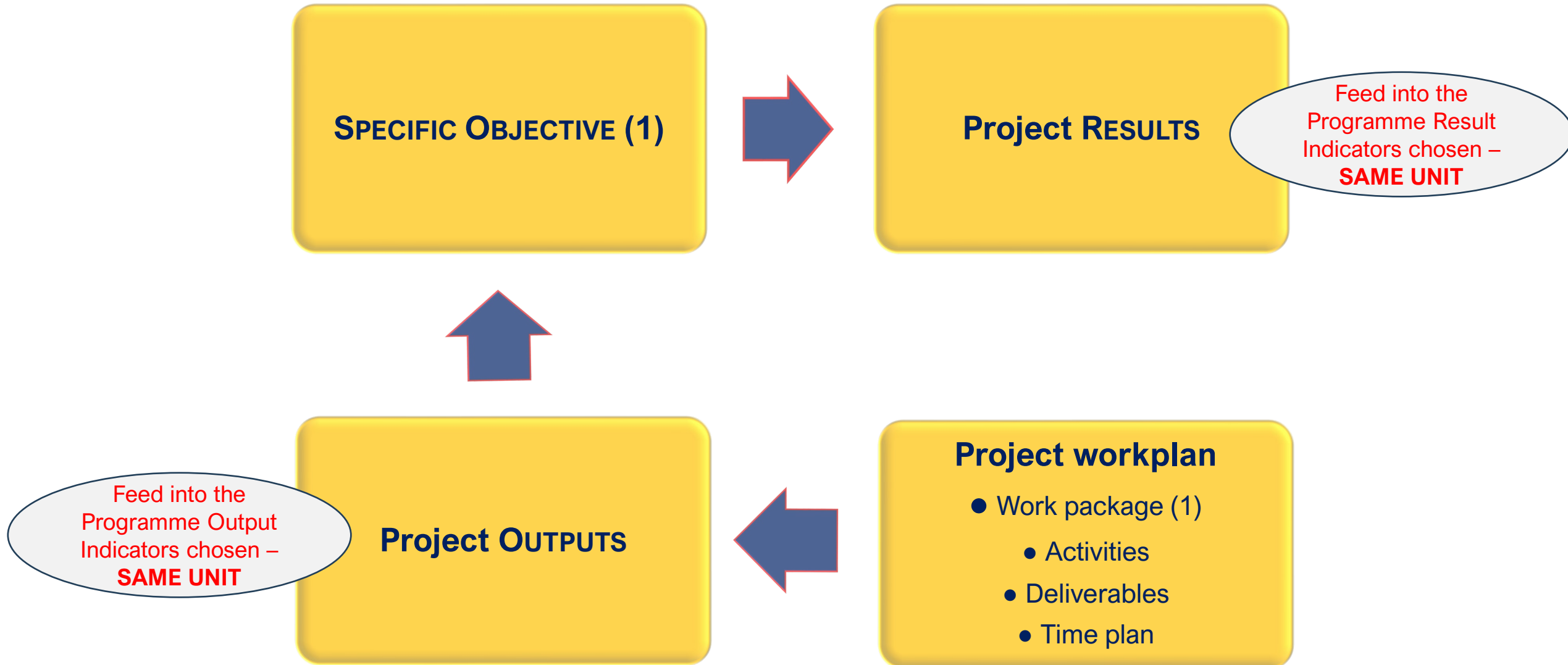
- **Product** that results from the implementation of **one OR more project activities**.

**(PROJECT) RESULT**

- Immediate **effect and change** (benefit) to be achieved in the area of cooperation through project outputs.

**(PROJECT) SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE**

- Immediate goal to be achieved until the **end of the project** through **activities and outputs**.

<b>RCO 87 – Organisations cooperating across borders</b>  Measurement unit = number of legal entities (project partners) involved in project implementation or <b>included in cooperation agreements</b> within the AF	<b>RCR 84 - Organisations cooperating across borders after project completion</b>  Measurement unit = organisations cooperating across borders after the completion of the supported projects	<b>MANDATORY</b>
<b>RCO 83 - Strategies and action plans jointly developed</b>  Measurement unit = the number of joint strategies, action plans developed by supported projects	<b>RCR 79 - Joint strategies and action plans taken up by organisations</b>  Measurement unit = the number of joint strategies and action plans (not individual actions) adopted and implemented by organisations during or after the project completion	<b>recommended</b>

<p><b>RCO 81 - Participations in joint actions across borders</b></p> <p><i>Measurement unit = the number of participations in joint actions across borders implemented in the supported projects</i></p>	<p><b>RCR 85 - Participations in joint actions across borders after project completion</b></p> <p><i>Measurement unit = the number of participations in joint actions across borders after the completion of the project, organised by all or some of the former partners/beneficiaries, as a continuation of cooperation</i></p>	<b>recommended</b>
<p><b>RCO 24- Investments in new or upgraded disaster monitoring, preparedness, warning and response systems against natural disasters</b></p> <p><i>Measurement unit = the value of investments</i></p>	<p><b>PSR 1- Population benefiting from protection measures against climate related natural disasters</b></p> <p><i>Measurement unit = an estimate of the population to benefit from measures against climate related natural disaster.</i></p>	<b>MANDATORY</b>

Indicators	Description
<b>RCO 87 - Organisations cooperating across borders</b>	<b>MANDATORY FOR ALL TYPES OF ACTION</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Only organisations formally cooperating (partners, associated organisations) are to be considered, AND must be counted only once.</li><li>● To be achieved at project completion.</li><li>● Only unique organizations cooperating are to be reported</li></ul>
<b>RCR 84 - Organisations cooperating across borders after project completion</b>	<b>MANDATORY FOR ALL TYPES OF ACTION</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Only organisations involved in project implementation (counted at RCO 87) and having a formal agreement are to be considered, AND must be counted only once.</li><li>● Measurement – at project completion <b>OR</b> one year after completion.</li></ul>

Output Indicators	Description
<b>RCO 83 - Strategies And Action Plans Jointly Developed</b>	<p><b>Common strategies and tools</b> for hazard management and risk prevention – joint action plans, technical and operational measures meant to ensure real-time coordinated actions, risk plans, intervention procedures, exercises, public awareness campaigns, elaborating of updated joint operational plans and procedural framework for efficient management and deployment of joint interventions, hydrological monitoring of rivers, water temperature, precipitation measurements, ice regime.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● A <b>joint strategy</b> establishes a targeted way to achieve a goal oriented process. An <b>action plan</b> translates an existing jointly developed strategy into actions.</li><li>● Organisations from both countries must be involved.</li></ul>
<b>RCR 79 - Joint strategies and action plans taken up by organisations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● By the end of the project, implementation of the strategy / action plan must <b>effectively start</b>.</li><li>● The organisations involved in take-up <b>may OR may not</b> be involved in project implementation.</li><li>● Measurement – one year after project completion.</li></ul>

Result Indicators	Description
<b>RCO 81 - Participations in Joint Actions Across Borders</b>	<p><i>Joint training programmes, joint exercises, networking, exchanging experience and knowledge, including raising awareness in the field of efficient risk prevention and management in the cross-border area, etc.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Participations</b> = number of persons attending / <b>Training</b> = no certificate needed</li> <li>● Participations in <b>public events</b> organized by the project are NOT to be counted in this indicator</li> <li>● Participations in events related to <b>project management</b> or other internal project meetings are NOT to be counted in this indicator</li> </ul>
<b>RCR 85 - Participations in joint actions across borders after project completion</b>	<p><i>Exchange activities, exchange visits, trainings</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Only data from RCO 81 are to be counted.</li> <li>● Joint actions – to be organized by all OR some of the former partners</li> <li>● Measurement – one year after project completion</li> </ul>

Result Indicators	Description
<b>RCO 24 - Investments in New or Upgraded Disaster Monitoring, Preparedness, Warning and Response Systems against Natural Disasters</b>	<p><b>MANDATORY FOR ALL TYPES OF ACTION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Value of investments in the project = target value for RCO 24</li><li>● Floods and fires are likely to be among the main natural threats affecting the territory, directly associated with climate change</li><li>● Measurement – at the time of completing the output</li></ul>
<b>PSR 1- Population benefiting from protection measures against climate related natural disasters</b>	<p><b>MANDATORY FOR ALL TYPES OF ACTION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Only persons residing in the programme are to be counted.</li><li>● Measurement – at the time of completing the output</li></ul>

- The **SMART** approach is required for a good quality project intervention logic
- Some programme **OUTPUT and RESULT indicators (in pairs)** are **mandatory** to be addressed by the projects
- Target values set for the output and result indicators must be **realistic** – do not over/under estimate them
- You **cannot use** the **same name** for deliverable, output or result (check the definitions !!)
- The contribution of **activities and outputs** to the **Specific Objective** must be clearly evidenced.
- It should be clear connection between the **Specific Objective and project results**.
