Challenges faced by higher education in Ukraine and Romania, particularly the need for inclusivity for people with disabilities and the rapid pace of digital transformation, as well as the gap in the preparedness of professionals to work with digital technologies, and the need for better integration of these technologies in education will be addressed.

The project aims to modernize educational infrastructure, develop virtual education tools, and create joint courses. Students, teachers, and academic staff will gain skills in digital technologies, personal growth, and financial and legal education.

Project Outcomes

- **1 Virtual learning platform** with at least **500 users**
- **3 accredited educational programs** in English/Romanian/Ukrainian entered into Virtual learning platform
- **20 Real-time speech-to-text translation devices (CART)**, providing access for people with hearing impairments to verbal information in real-time during lectures and events
- **20 Height-adjustable tables** for wheelchair users
- **3 cross-border pilot schools for training of target groups** based on developed educational programs
