### The problem. **Project's solution**

Dolyna and Baia Sprie face major healthcare challenges: outdated infrastructure and equipment, staff shortages due to emigration, limited access for vulnerable groups, and poor health indicators.

To address these, the project will modernize medical facilities, introduce telemedicine and mobile medical teams, improve staff training, and promote health education. These actions will ensure better access to quality care for all population segments, especially the elderly and vulnerable, and will strengthen crossborder cooperation in healthcare service delivery.

#### **Project Outcomes**

- abt. 27,000 people will benefit annually from the modernised health care facilities
- rehabilitation of the Dolyna Diagnostic Center and purchase and installation of specialized medical and non-medical equipment (microbiological analyzer, automatic perimeter, uninterruptible power supplies, telemedicine etc),
- 1 minibus for transporting patients with limited mobility
- rehabilitation of the Baia Sprie Geriatric Center and purchase and installation of specialized medical and non-medical equipment (basic medical instruments, electric medical beds, furniture, telemedicine, etc)
- 2 telemedicine services implemented
- 1 mobile medical group created in Dolyna Diagnostic Center
- 2 trainings organized for the staff of the two medical institutions
- 4 experience exchanges between medical staff from Dolyna and Baia Sprie
