## The problem. Project's solution

Increasing climate-related water risks, cross-border water management pressures, and the growing frequency of severe floods in the Siret River basin are affecting communities in Romania and Ukraine.

To address these issues, the project proposes a joint operational guide for coordinated interventions, cross-border cooperation between water authorities, and modern monitoring equipment, including ADCP systems and drones, to improve flood management and response time.

## Project Outcomes

- **endowment of Siret Water Basin Administration** (motor pumps, 2 generators with light tower, large generator, specialized vehicles for intervention, ADCP boat, Welding generator group for dam intervention, UTV Electrical off-road, drone, IT equipment, etc)
- **endowment of Prut-Siret Basin Department of Water Resources** (excavator, tractor, trawl, specialized vehicle, IT equipment, etc)
- **endowment of Siret Town** (Bulldozer, including other accessories for flood management, tractor with trailer, electricity generator (with lights), electricity generator of high capacity).
- **1 operational work procedure** for the joint intervention of the water authorities
- **2 events to raise awareness of the population** in the field of floods
- **3 organisations cooperating across border**
