### The problem. Project's solution

High exposure to floods, forest fires, droughts, and other natural or man-made disasters, particularly in smaller and more remote communities with limited emergency response capacity are important challenges in the project's area.

To address these issues, the project proposes joint cross-border cooperation through procurement of modern equipment, development of a common intervention procedure, improved early warning tools, and awareness-raising actions to strengthen preparedness and response.

- **endowment of Milisauti City** (Fire Truck with accessories, water and foam UTV, Tractor, 5 Portable fire engine pump, 3 electricity generator, 3 emergency response tents, 10 Hydrants, rescue boat, detection, signaling and extinguishing system, equipment for firefighters, etc)
- **endowment of Novoselytsya City Council** (Backhoe Loader equipped, Combined road car, 3 High-pressure gasoline pump, Catamaran, 10 Uninterruptible power supply, equipment for firefighters, etc)
- **1 Mobile application** for informing the population from the Milisauti and Novoselytsya areas
- **4 workshops** for volunteers
- **2 training sessions** for 20 persons on topics related to how to use the equipment
- **1 commune procedure for intervention**
- **2 organisations cooperating across border**
