## FIRE-FLOOD FIGHT


### The problem. Project's solution

Frequent natural disasters—intensified by climate change—pose growing risks in both partner communities, including floods, fires, and landslides that threaten infrastructure, livelihoods, and safety.

To address these challenges, the partners propose an integrated response: strengthening riverbanks and emergency infrastructure, procuring firefighting and intervention equipment, and organizing joint trainings and disaster-response exercises to improve preparedness, resilience, and cross-border cooperation.

- **Construction of the headquarters of the Emergency Situations Volunteer Service** in Piscolt Commune
- **Restoration of the Strymba River bank** in Nadvirna City for flood prevention.
- **endowment of Piscolt Commune** (Fire Truck with accessories, fire autovehicle for fast intervention, miniexcavator, defibrillators, civil and disaster alarm system, equipment for firefighters, etc)
- **endowment of Nadvirna City** (bulldozer, excavator, etc)
- **4 four common exercises** for 80 emergency volunteers
- **400 brochures** published on the theme of how to react in case of disasters, published by Nadvirna City and Piscolt Commune
- **First aid** training for 60 participants
- **100 people** informed about the project
- **2 organisations cooperating across border**
